ARCHITECTURE – OLD CORE

The following courses will transfer into Detroit Mercy's Architecture Program. Students may transfer a maximum of 63 credits toward a Bachelor's Degree; course grades must be a 2.0 or better. Generally, a 3.0 GPA at HFC is necessary for admission. We encourage you to meet with a Detroit Mercy School of Architecture administrator to discuss individual curriculum plans. If transfer credit is not granted for the equivalent course, elective credit toward your degree may be awarded.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Generally, a 3.0 GPA at HFC (and/or other accredited institutions) is necessary for admission. We encourage you to meet with a Detroit Mercy School of Architecture administrator to discuss individual curriculum plans.
- If less than 24 credits have been earned, a student's high school transcript is required.
- Students may transfer a maximum of 63 credits toward a Bachelor's Degree; course grades must be 2.0 or better.
- Apply for admission to Detroit Mercy at udmercy.edu/apply; the application is free.
