In order to apply to the Detroit Mercy Physician Assistant program, undergraduate students from Detroit Mercy must follow application guidelines including (but not limited to): at least 1000 hours of hands-on health care experience, all designated coursework completed (as outlined by the department), and a letter of recommendation from a biology faculty member. MTA Students only: Transfer students who satisfy the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) will have the Core Knowledge Area requirements met (listed on page 1 of this guide). Fulfilling the Core Integrating Themes is still necessary.

## **ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS**

- Minimum 2.50 GPA based on 24 or more credits earned at Mott CC (and/or other accredited institutions).
- If less than 24 credits have been earned, a student's high school transcript is required.
- Apply for admission to Detroit Mercy at udmercy.edu/apply; the application is free.
