RN-TO-BSN/NURSING DEGREE COMPLETION PROGRAM

The following courses will transfer into UDM's Nursing Degree Completion program. Course grades must be a C or better. Students in this program may transfer a maximum of 51 credits from WC3 and/or other accredited institutions. Nursing Degree Completion students also receive 45 credits for their RN license for a total of 96 credits toward their BSN degree at UDM. Students must take a minimum of 30 credits at UDM to earn their BSN.
